



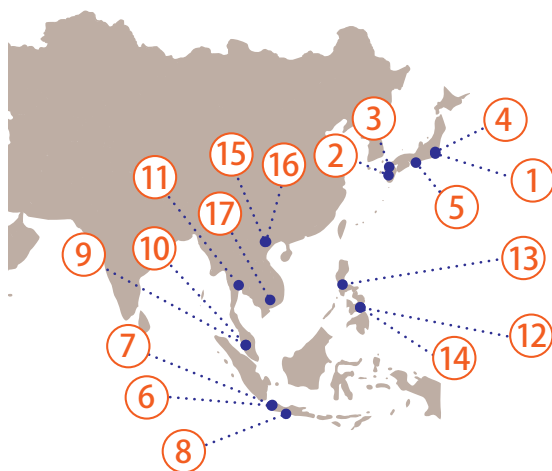

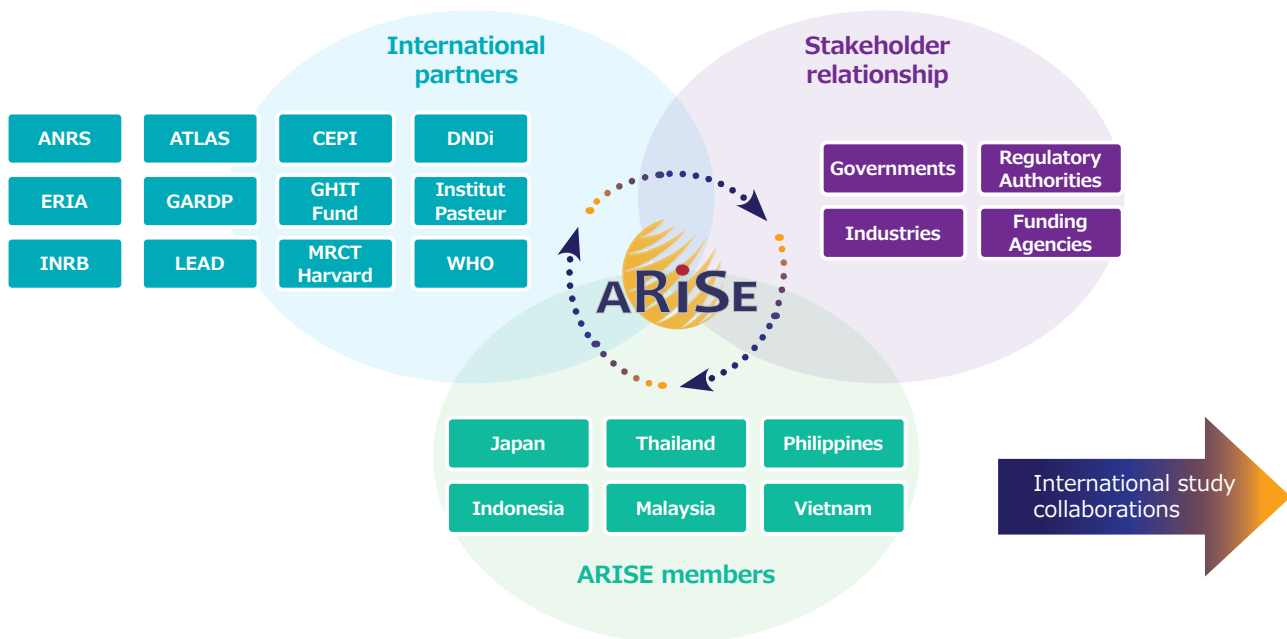

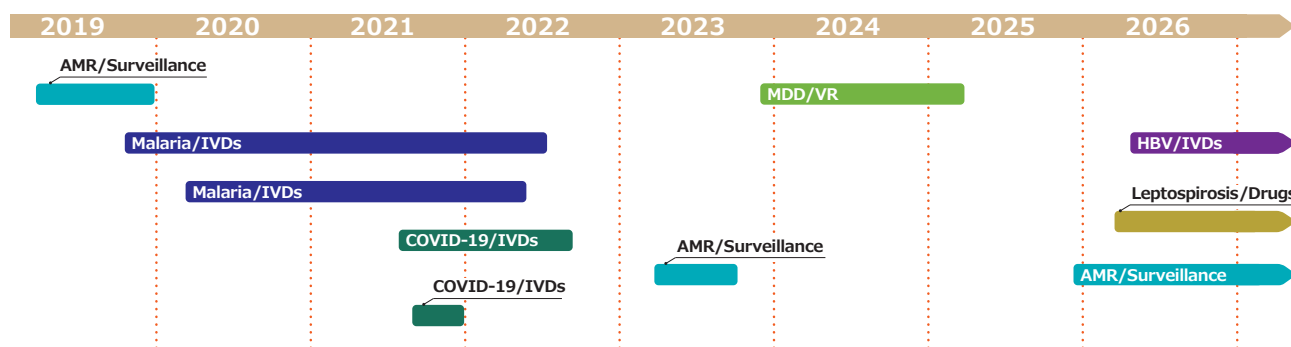
- To be a **leading and reliable collaborative network of AROs in Asia** that will facilitate and optimize the conduct of infectious diseases clinical trials.

Our Activities

The ARISE international trial platform provides functions that are made possible due to its nature as a multi-country ARO network, for the implementation of clinical study projects including multiregional trials. We support the conduct of clinical trials from concept to implementation stage - protocol design, site selection, management and reporting of trial results. To build competence and capacity to conduct high quality trials, we collaborate to develop a comprehensive capacity building for knowledge transfer and information sharing across the network.
